## Conditions to Application 4/01578/10/FUL

Condition 3:- Storage Refuse

No development shall take place until details of facilities for the storage of refuse shall have been submitted to and approved in writing by the local planning authority. The approved facilities shall the be provided before the development is first brought into use.

Condition 4-5:- Soft/Hard Landscape

No development shall take place until full details of both hard and soft landscape works shall have been submitted to and approved in writing by the local planning authority. These shall include:

Hard surfacing
means of enclosure
soft landscape works which shall include planting plan specifications of plants, sizes, numbers etc
trees to be retained

Condition 8:- Vehicle Parking

The development hereby permitted shall not be occupied until the arrangements for vehicle parking.

Condition 9:- Visibility Splays

Provide 2.0m x2.0m pedestrian visibility splays. Ensure no obstruction to visibility, above 600mm high from the finished access ground level, is created in the sight splays. Ensure that visibility is maintained permanently as such thereafter.

Provide vehicle splays of not less than 43m x 2.4m before any part of the development hereby permitted is first brought into use, and thereafter shall be maintained, in both directions from the crossover, within which there shall be no obstruction to visibility between a height of 600mm and 2.0m above the carriageway.

## Note: Frontage Planter

Existing Yew and Scott Pine trees to be removed. New replacements within the frontage are to be of same or similar type in appearance.

Every endevour will be made to retain all existing trees/shrubs within the new access points with additions as required so that the native appearance will remain and the front landscape with be consistant with neighbouring streetscenes.
